

How We Fill Short-time Positions for Youth

If we are looking for a student or former student to fill a project position, we contact Universities or Colleges within Greater Victoria, or the Lower Mainland to arrange for a job bulletin to be posted for students that are interested in positions in their area of study. They are hired under specific programs as outlined below.

Youth Employment Programs

The Youth Employment Program is for students who have attended an accredited educational institution (including high school) within the last six months but who are not registered in a coop program. Work programs last from one to four months.

Coop Education Training Program

The Coop Education Training Program is for students enrolled in a recognized cooperative education program at a participating post-secondary institution, working towards a diploma or a degree. Work assignments integrate students' academic studies with related hands-on experience in their field of choice.

Assignments are typically for four months, or no more than eight months in a 16-month period, though depend on the institution's requirements.
