PRIVATE RECORDS

- Church registers of baptisms, marriages, and burials** Search the [BC Archives Collection](#) and the old manuscript (Old MS) card catalogue within the reference room by church name (e.g., St. Andrew's Presbyterian Church) or subject (e.g., "registers of births", "religious records"). Visit [Memory BC](#) to search for other BC church record holdings.
- Family papers** Search by family name for diaries, correspondence, and family trees via the [BC Archives Collection](#) and the Old MS card catalogue within the reference room.
- [MS-0700](#) - Notes on Colonial farm settlers on the mainland of British Columbia [1858-1871], 1939.
- [MS-0467](#) – Letterbook [March 1894] and questionnaires [distributed to settlers in the North West Territory 1884-1885], 1884-1894. Includes one volume completed by women settlers.
